## **CODE ENFORCEMENT**

Residents already residing in the City of Velda Village Hills must have a current Occupancy
Permit on file.

Home owners must obtain an Occupancy INSPECTION

BEFORE renting the property.

Cost = \$95.35

New Residents must obtain an Occupancy PERMIT BEFORE moving in. Cost = \$40 Violators = \$25/day

\*Residents who own or drive a vehicle are required to obtain a City Sticker. Cost = \$5 AFTER FEBRUARY = \$7

Pet owners are required to obtain a pet license. Cost = ss

\*All Code Violations (i.e...high grass, nuisance properties, etc.) are assessed a fine of \$100.50 + court cost \$29.50 TOTAL = \$130

maintained.


