## CODE ENFORCEMENT

\*Residents already residing in the City of Velda Village Hills must have a current Occupancy Permit on file.

\*New Residents must obtain an Occupancy Permit BEFORE moving in.  
Cost = \$40 Violators = \$25/day

\*Home owners must obtain an Occupancy Inspection BEFORE renting the property.  
Cost = \$95.35

\*Pet owners are required to obtain a pet license.  
Cost = \$5

\*All Code Violations (i.e....high grass, nuisance properties, etc.) are assessed a fine of \$100.50 + court cost \$29.50.  
TOTAL = \$130

\*YOU MUST OBTAIN A WORK PERMIT FOR BUILDING, ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING, OR MECHANICAL REPAIR
